

# Protect your investment

A healthy roof consists of many parts. With the Owens Corning Roofing and Asphalt, LLC ("Owens Corning") Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty," every Owens Corning" component — including installation — of your Total Protection Roofing System<sup>\*^</sup> is covered by an extended limited warranty, **including a 10-year limited warranty**\* **on workmanship**<sup>5</sup> **coverage.** It's a smart way to help ensure your investment is protected for years to come.

### Peace of mind

The Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty\* has up to a 50-year "non-prorated" period for both material defects and the labor to repair or replace them, whereas many standard warranties have a 10-year non-prorated warranty period. With the Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty,\* you can rest easy knowing you have this coverage.

In addition, you will receive 10 years of workmanship<sup>5</sup> protection. Meaning, if your roof is found to have an application error, Owens Corning Roofing will arrange to have it repaired, with labor, materials, tear-off and disposal costs all covered.

### Coverage

The Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty\* provides coverage for both material defects and the labor to repair or replace them, including tear-off and disposal.

Additionally, every Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> roofing component, except the electrical components of the VentSure<sup>®</sup> Solar Attic Exhaust Fan, and VentSure<sup>®</sup> off-ridge exhaust vents, take on the warranty of the shingle installed, in many cases, extending their warranty period. The Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty<sup>\*</sup> does not cover non-Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> roofing components such as flashing, fasteners, pipe boots and wood decking.

## One-time transfer\*

Whether you're staying in your home for years to come or planning to sell, the Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty is transferable,\* making it an excellent investment. If you're planning to sell, this warranty may provide a highly desirable benefit to future homebuyers.

### Requirements

To be eligible for the Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranty,\* you must purchase and install Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> shingles and at least four of the following Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> roofing components (one product from each category where applicable):

- Owens Corning Underlayment products: Deck Defense<sup>®</sup> High Performance Roof Underlayment, ProArmor<sup>®</sup> Synthetic Roof Underlayment, RhinoRoof<sup>®</sup> U20, Titanium<sup>®</sup> UDL25, Titanium<sup>®</sup> UDL30, Titanium<sup>®</sup> UDL50 Synthetic Roof Underlayment or FIBERGLAS<sup>®</sup> Reinforced Felt.
  Note: This component is required on all Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranties.
- Owens Corning<sup>\*</sup> Hip & Ridge Shingles. Note: This component is required on all Preferred Protection Roofing System Limited Warranties with shingles having a limited Lifetime warranty\* (see chart).
- Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> WeatherLock<sup>®</sup>, Titanium<sup>®</sup> PSU30, or RhinoRoof<sup>®</sup> Self-Sealing Ice & Water Barrier products.
- Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> Starter Shingle products.
- Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> VentSure<sup>®</sup> Ventilation products: If a VentSure<sup>®</sup> product is used it must be part of a balanced air ventilation system consisting of both functional intake and exhaust ventilation products. If a VentSure<sup>®</sup> intake vent AND VentSure<sup>®</sup> exhaust vent are both used, this will count as one of the four requirements previously mentioned.

In addition, you must meet the following requirements:


- An Owens Corning Roofing Platinum or Preferred Contractor must install your roofing system and adhere to local building codes.
- Your roofing system must be installed over an approved underlayment on a clean roof deck with all existing roofing material and debris removed.\*

This warranty must be registered by your Owens Corning Roofing Platinum or Preferred Contractor within 60 days of the installation.

# The Total Protection Roofing System



Total Protection Roofing System<sup>\*^</sup> is the name we give our system of Owens Corning<sup>\*</sup> roofing components. The graphic below helps you see where these Owens Corning<sup>\*</sup> roofing products are typically located on a roof deck. From beautiful, water-shedding Owens Corning<sup>\*</sup> shingles to ventilation, ice and water deck barrier and starter shingle products, the Owens Corning<sup>\*</sup> Total Protection Roofing System<sup>\*</sup> is designed to increase the performance of your roof. Non-Owens Corning<sup>\*</sup> products, such as flashing, fasteners, pipe boots and wood decking, are not covered under the terms of this warranty.

NOTE: Owens Corning does not warrant non-Owens Corning<sup>®</sup> products. For best results, Owens Corning strongly recommends the use of non-neoprene, metal, lead, or ridged plastic pipe flashing around all plumbing vents.
